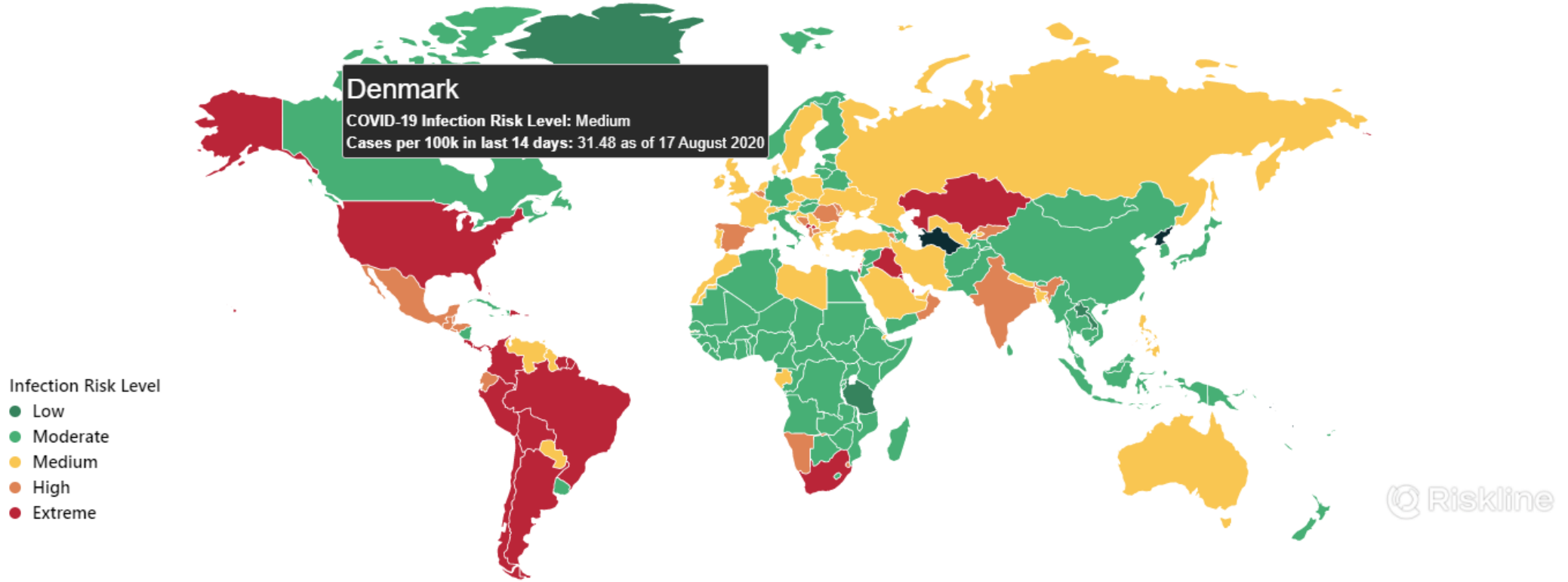


World Map Infection

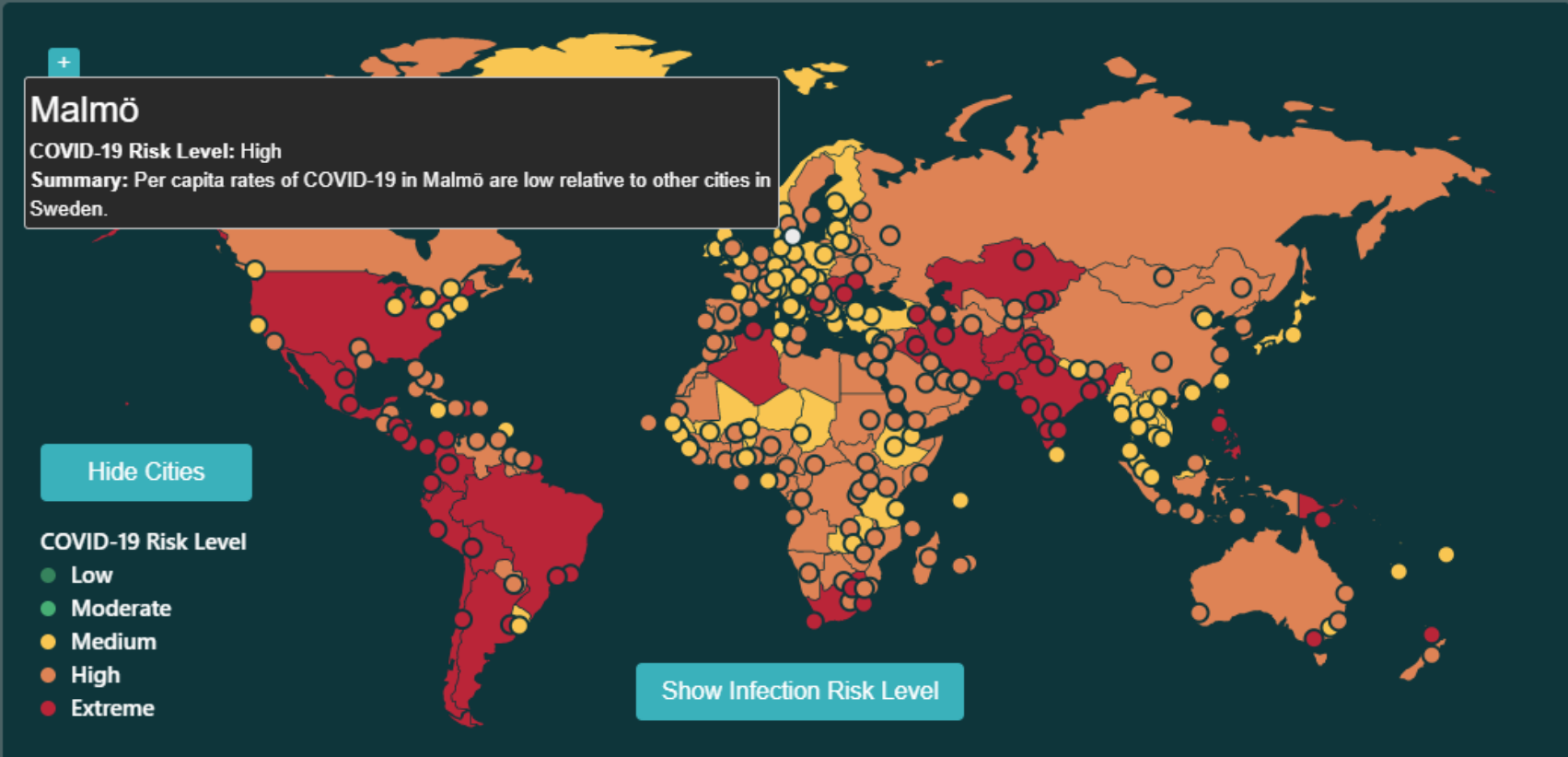

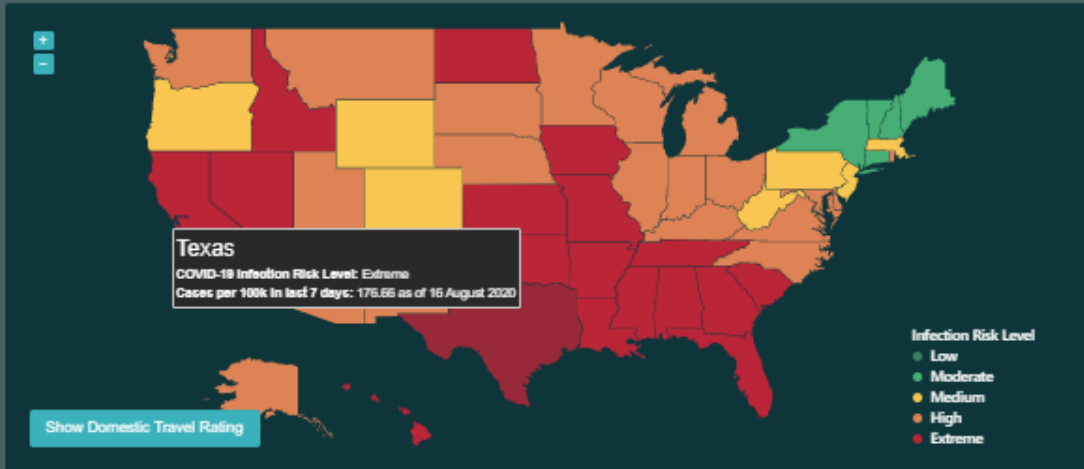

3 COVID-19 measures tightened in St Louis metro area from 18 August 1 day ago

Illinois Governor J. B. Pritzker announced that the Metro East region counties of Bond, Clinton, Madison, Monroe, Randolph, St Clair and Washington must implement enhanced COVID-19 measures from 18 August due to a rise in cases. Bars, restaurants and casinos will close at 23:00 local time (04:00 GMT) daily, following the enactment of similar rules in neighbouring St Louis, Missouri; gatherings are capped at 25 people.

3 Social distancing measures extended in Mississippi through 31 August - Update 2 days ago

Governor Tate Reeves extended social distancing orders, which includes a statewide requirement to wear face masks in public, until 08:00 local time (13:00 GMT) on 31 August as part of efforts to limit the spread of COVID-19; the measures were previously set to expire on 17 August.

3 COVID-19 measures extended in Georgia through 31 August - Update 2 days ago

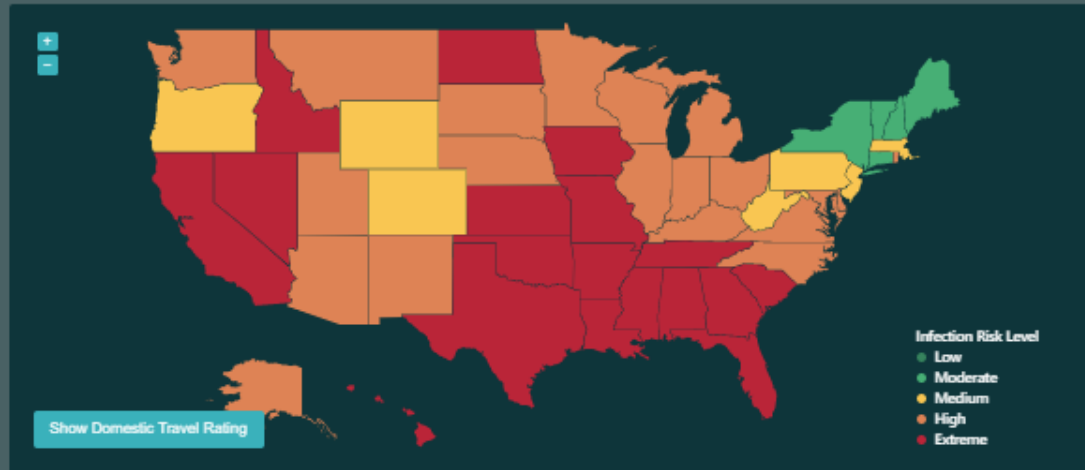
Georgia Governor Brian Kemp announced the extension of the ongoing COVID-19 restrictions through 31 August; a public health state of emergency also remains in effect through 10 September. Gatherings of over 50 people remain banned unless a two-metre (six-feet) distance can be practiced. Face masks are strongly encouraged in public. A shelter in place order remains in place for residents of nursing homes and those with chronic health conditions.

Summary

Authorities imposed international travel restrictions from late February – a month after the first cases were detected in the country – and nationwide social distancing guidelines from late March. The country has the highest case and fatality figures in the world. From March, stay-at-home lockdown began to be implemented as the virus spread across the country. All states have begun reopening as of June at widely varying paces, yet also reimposing some restrictions after a resurgence of cases in some states. Health authorities still warn against any non-essential travel despite the reopenings. Around 240 cases per 100,000 people were reported in the past 14 days, as of early August.

International Travel

International Flights

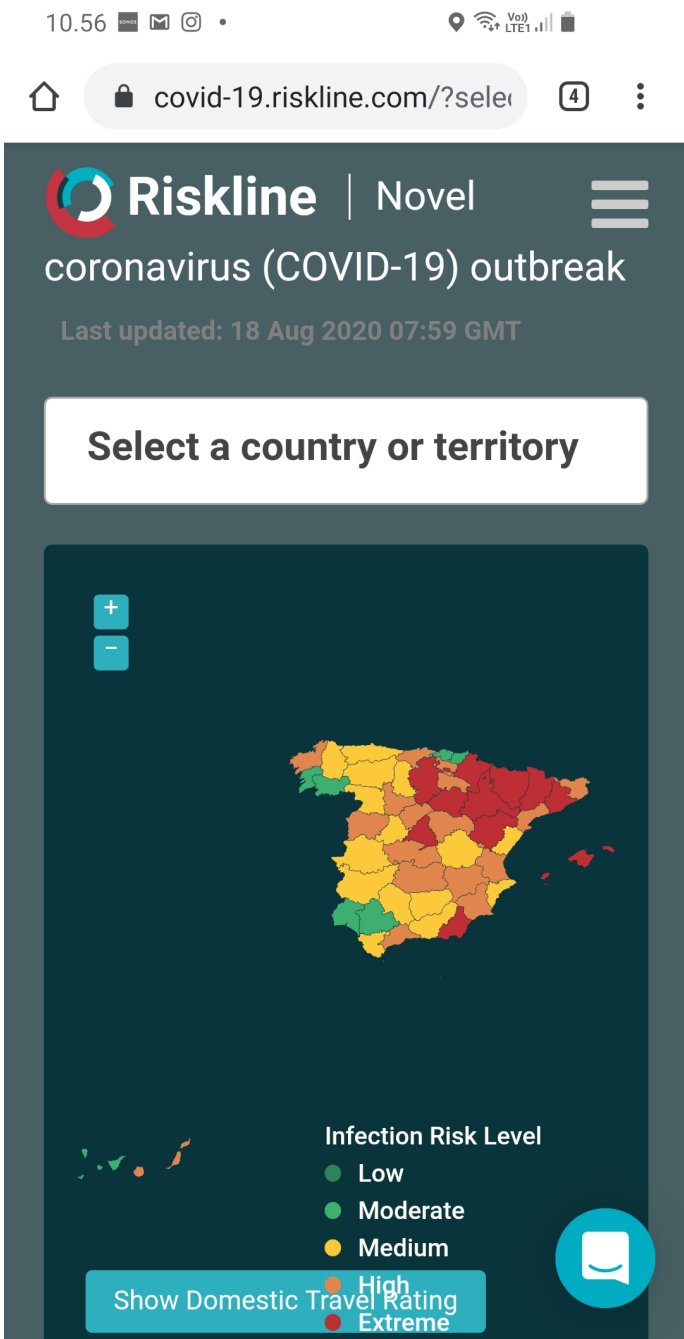
American Airlines, United Airlines, Delta Air Lines and other major carriers have suspended most flights to China, Hong Kong, Macau, the UK, continental Europe and Latin America, through April and beyond. Officials partially lifted a ban on flights by Air China, China Eastern Airlines, China Southern Airlines, and Xiamen Airlines from 16 June after the Chinese authorities allowed United and Delta airlines to operate one round-trip between the two countries.

Entry and Borders

A ban on tourist visitors from all of Canada, Mexico, Brazil, Europe and much of Asia remains in place. Travellers who have transited through Brazil, Austria, Belgium, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Italy, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, the UK and Ireland within 14 days of their planned arrival in the US are banned from entering the US; the restrictions do not apply to legal permanent residents or US citizens and their immediate

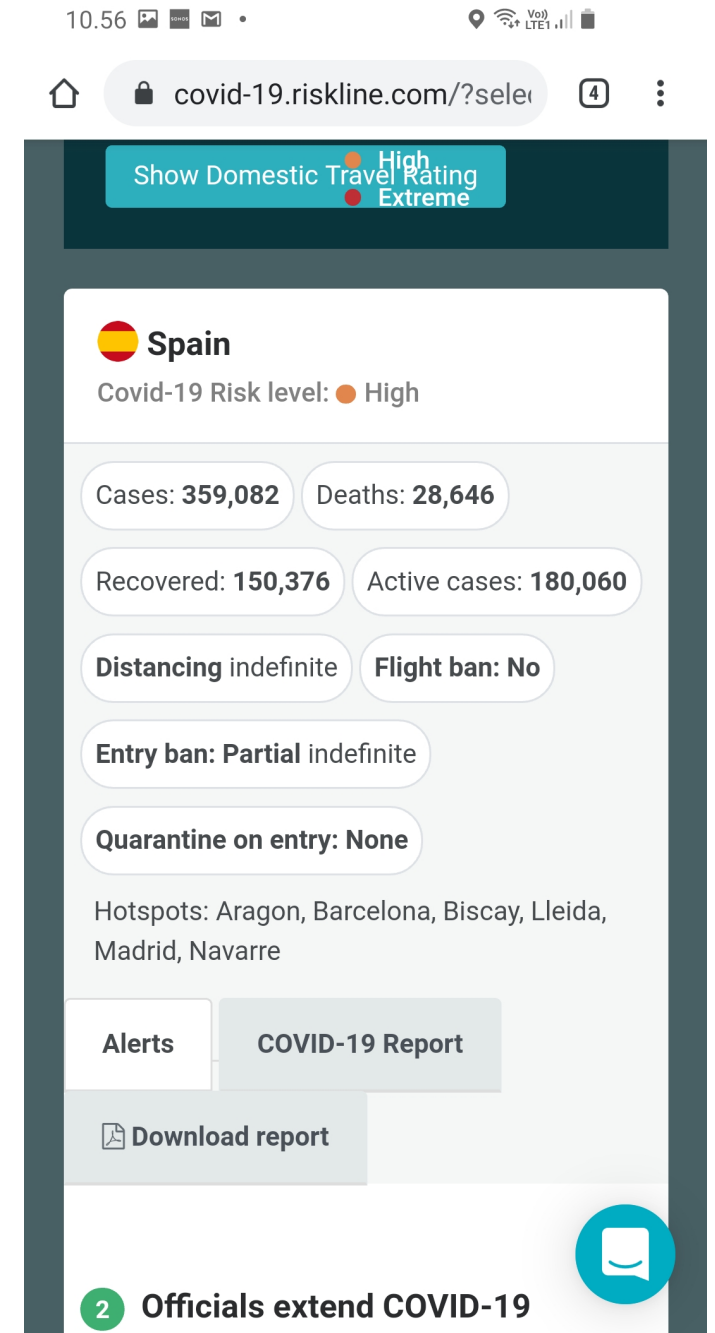

2 Officials extend COVID-19 measures in multiple regions - Update

about 18 hours ago

Updated reports indicated that authorities extended a ban on the operations of restaurants after 00:00 local time (22:00 GMT) and smoking outdoors in Andalusia, Castile and Leon, Galicia and Cantabria, as part of continued efforts to contain the COVID-19 pandemic. Nightclubs and bars will remain closed. It is unclear when these measures will be lifted.

3 Select businesses close nationwide due to COVID-19 spike - Update

4 days ago

Authorities announced that select businesses, such as discotheques, bars and nightclubs, were closed nationwide until further notice due a recent spike in COVID-19 cases at these types of establishments; restaurants were also ordered to close by 01:00 local time (23:00 GMT) daily.

Entry and Borders

Borders are open to travellers from all European Union and Schengen Area countries and the United Kingdom, as well as residents of Andorra, Monaco, the Vatican and San Marino. The land border with Portugal reopened. Travel restrictions are in effect for most countries outside the European Union and the Schengen Area. Residents of Australia, Canada, Georgia, Japan, New Zealand, Rwanda, South Korea, Thailand, Tunisia and Uruguay are allowed to enter, following a European Union (EU) recommendation to lift travel restrictions for these countries. The country remains closed to entry from China and Morocco due to a lack of a reciprocal measure.

Quarantine

There is no requirement for international arrivals to quarantine.

Other Restrictions

Travellers must complete a health control form on the website <https://www.spth.gob.es/> and obtain a QR code to present upon arrival. The form can be also completed on the mobile app "Spain Travel Health APP".

All passengers arriving by air and sea will undergo a temperature check. Those suspected of having COVID-19 will be subject to an
